- Rolling backpacks are discouraged. They are often hard for children to maneuver/hang on hooks.
- Locker shelves may be suggested for students using lockers. Please check with your teacher.
- **Please mark all clothing with your child's name. This will aid us in returning lost and found items throughout the year.**
- Please note that there may be a few changes to the list once the school year begins.

Kindergarten:

Please mark all items with your child's name.

2 sturdy paper pocket folders (no center brackets)	2 boxes of tissues
8 pack of washable crayons (2 boxes)	2 rolls of paper towels
6 glue sticks (wide/thick)	School scissors
4 sharpened pencils—no sharpeners	Extra set of clothes
Large towel and very small pillow for nap time	Sleeping mat from Wal-Mart
1 large bottle of handwash (Softsoap)	

Choose two of the following to send in: paper plates, plastic silverware, napkins, cheese crackers, pretzels, goldfish, small cookies, graham crackers, etc. (Children will need only a juice box (**no** grape) or thermos for snack unless they have allergies to foods listed above.)

First Grade:

Please mark all items with your child's name.

Plastic green pocket folder	12, #2 sharpened pencils
Plastic red pocket folder	4 glue sticks
8 pack of washable crayons (2 boxes)	2 rolls of paper towels
Small bottle of Elmer's glue	2 boxes of tissues
Scissors (child's size)	Package of forks or spoons
Water bottle – optional	Ruler – should have inches and centimeters. Wooden or see-through plastic rulers are recommended. Glitter types are hard to read. No flexible rulers please.
\$2 to purchase writing paper (teachers will purchase paper so that all students are using the same size/style paper).	

Second Grade:

Please mark all items with your child's name.

Third Grade:

1 ruler with inches and centimeters
1 plain/basic blue 3-ring binder
1 box of tissues
1 box of plastic spoons and/or forks
24, #2 sharpened pencils (plain, no mechanical)
1 bottle of hand sanitizer (Purell/Germ-X)
1 water bottle
12 sturdy, plain pocket folders: 2 red, 2 green, 4 blue, & 4 yellow

Fourth Grade:

1 inch 3-ring binder w/5 dividers
2 boxes of tissues
1 package of construction paper
Marble composition book
1 bottle of hand sanitizer
Large container of wipes
2 **sturdy** pocket folders (1 blue, 1 red)

Small school supply box to hold:

2 blue or black pens, 2 dry erase markers, small box of crayons, school scissors, eraser pencil caps,
3 glue sticks, 3" square Post-It notes, 10 pencils (mechanical or plain #2), small pkg of colored pencils or markers
