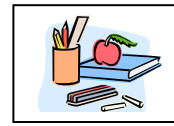


# Dayspring Christian Academy

## K-5<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

### 2011-2012



- Children in 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade should bring a **healthy** snack every day. **Please do not send Kool-Aid or power drinks or drinks with caffeine.** (See below for information on Kindergarten snacks.)
- Students in K-5<sup>th</sup> grade will receive a planner to use throughout the year.
- Please review the school's dress code in the parent/student handbook or on-line before purchasing back-to-school clothing. Modesty is the standard!
- Rolling backpacks are discouraged. They are often hard for children to maneuver on stairs/hang on hooks.
- **Please mark all clothing, lunch boxes and other personal items with your child's name. This will aid in returning any lost and found items throughout the year.**
- Please note that there may be a few changes to the list once the school year begins.
- Office supply donations of Expo dry erase markers & board cleaner, sticki-tack, tissues, and wipes are welcome.

**Choose two of the following to send in:** Please send in one food item (cheese crackers, pretzels, goldfish, small cookies, graham crackers, etc) and one other item (plastic forks/spoons, paper plates, napkins). Children will need only a juice box (**no red or grape**) or thermos for snack unless they have allergies to foods listed above. A box of quart and a box of gallon size ziploc bags. (off brand is fine, regular or freezer, 10 or so per box for snacks & crafts.)

#### Small school supply box to hold:

2 blue or black pens, 2 dry erase markers, school scissors, eraser or eraser caps, 3 glue sticks, 3" square Post-It notes, 20 sharpened pencils, 1 highlighter

1 pink Pearl eraser  
12-inch ruler (must be **metric** and inches)  
6 sharpened pencils (plain #2 or mechanical)  
Dictionary (optional)  
1 bottle hand sanitizer

### Fine Arts:

Kindergarten – 1 package of glue sticks  
First grade – 1 pack of construction paper  
Second grade – 1 box of thin markers  
Third grade – 1 box of thick markers  
Fourth grade – 1 set of 8 water colors  
Fifth grade girls – 1 box of wipes or tissues  
Fifth grade boys – 1 package of pencils or package of Pearl erasers
