The proposed Statement of Faith amendment would add Paragraphs H and I to Article II of the bylaws:

H. We believe that God created each human biologically and immutably male or female as a reflection of His image; and we recognize each individual according to their God-given biological gender including (but not limited to) pronoun usage, bathroom and locker room usage, dress code, and athletic participation. Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person. (Gen. 1:26-31; 2:18-25; 5:1, 2; Matthew 19:4). We believe that all forms of sexual activity - outside of the biblical definition of marriage as being exclusively between one man and one woman - are sinful, harmful, and outside the bounds of God's established standard for healthy and righteous human intimacy. (Genesis 1:27; 2:24; Matthew 19:4-6; 1 Corinthians 6:9, 18-19; Ephesians 5:31-32; 1 Timothy 1:8-11; Hebrews 13:4)

I. We affirm that God's grace is greater than all of our sin, and anyone who places their faith in Christ alone for salvation is no longer identified by their past sins but is cleansed and fully accepted in Christ. As followers of Christ, we are to pursue our own personal sanctification and growth in Christlikeness while demonstrating His love and compassion for all people. (John 13:34-35, John 8:11; Romans 5:20-21, Romans 6:1-2, Romans 7:14-25; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; Ephesians 1:6-7; Colossians 2:10-14; 1 John 3:1-3, 1 John 4:7).
