Beginning May 23, students can accumulate points by taking photos of the following people and places. Each photo will earn the points shown below. Items shown in blue can earn 1 additional point for each extra photo submitted that meets the listed criteria and features a different person or location (Maximum 10 points per category). All photos will receive double points if the DCA logo is visible in the photo (DCA Shirt is acceptable) and 1 additional point if you include your pet. Photos must be taken prior to August 15 and submitted to DCAScavengerHunt@dcamail.org by August 16 to be counted.

- National or State Park Sign (1pt)
- “World’s Largest”...roadside attraction (3pt)
- Travelling on a plane, train, tour bus, or cruise ship (2 pt)
- Entrance Sign to a college (1pt)
- US Route 66 road sign (3pt)
- “You must be this tall to ride” sign (1pt)
- Volcano, cave, or cavern (1pt)
- Space vessel (2pt)
- Reenacting a movie scene at the location of the movie (2pt)
- At a professional or college sports game (1pt)
- Lego creation taller than the student (2pt)
- Gargoyle (3pt)
- “Highest Elevation” sign (1pt)
- Tri-state marker (1pt for each state meeting at the point)
- Ticket stub for a museum, play, opera or concert in front of bding (2pt)
- Horse and Buggy (2pt)
- A sunset (1pt)
- Fountain (1pt)
- An open Chick-Fil-A with less than 4 cars in drive through (3pt)
- Telephone Booth (2pt)
- Virginia LOVE sign (1pt)
- Decorated water towers (1pt)
- Road/traffic sign with student’s name (first, middle, or last) (3pt)

- Statue or bust of a President or Vice-Pres. (2pt / 5pt for actual person)
- US Representative or Senator (3pt)
- State or Federal Capital Building (2pt)

Military:

- Shaking hands with non-related serviceman or woman in uniform (2pt)
- Revolutionary or Civil war battlefield (2pt)
- War plane, helicopter, tank, or cannon (2pt)
- An interpretive sign explaining a military movement or battle (3pt)

Activities with Family and Friends:

- Outdoor activity with a non-related student (1pt)
- Giving a gift (or hug) to a present or former DCA teacher /staff member (1pt)
- Mr. Hawks in a wig (1pt)
- Mr. Smith in a small space (1pt)
- Student with non-related DCA alumni (2pt)
- Family photo showing 3 or more generations (1pt for each generation)
- Serving at church (4pt)
- Serving the community (3pt)
- Playing a board game (1pt)
- Eating food from a food truck (2pt)
- Planting or harvesting a garden or flowers (1pt)
- Eating Sushi (2pt)
- Making s’mores (1pt)
- Putt-putt (2pt)
