REMINDER OF ELECTRONICS USE POLICY:

- Students are NOT allowed to use electronics during the school day. Electronics include any type of IPOD, mp3 player, kindle, handheld video games, smart phone, etc.* These items should not be brought to school. Students are allowed to have a cell phone at school as long as it is kept off and out of sight throughout the school day. Students are allowed to go to the office to use their cell phone to make important phone calls.
