- Rolling backpacks are discouraged. They are often hard for children to maneuver on stairs/hang on hooks.

Kindergarten:

 1 small dry erase board*
 1 watercolor pallet*
 Sleeping mat (sold at WalMart/Target/Amazon)*
 Large towel and **very small** pillow for nap time

Extra set of clothes in a ziplock-type bag labeled with child's name)*
 2 bottles of disinfecting wipes (food-safe ones are best)
 1 roll of paper towels
 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
 1 package forks
 1 package of paper plates

 Boys - 1 packages of napkins
 Girls - 1 box of tissues
 Boys - 1 box of gallon sized storage bags
 Girls - 1 box of zip top sandwich bags
